Meeting Minutes

October 13, 2009

Call to Order

Keith Adams called to order the regular Center Grove wrestling Club Board meeting on October 13, 2009 at Center Grove High School.

Roll Call

Those present were Cale Hoover, Keith Adams, Jeff Johnson, Neil Segó, Jay Yates, Ed Lyons, Karen Carmichael, Cindy Thrasher, and Renee Schoettle.

Minutes from the September 22 meeting have been posted on the CGWC website with no objections.

Business

1. Financial Update

- a. Keith Adams handed out current profit and loss comparison through October 13, 2009. Current checking account balance is \$3,389.42.
- b. The powder puff game brought in less than the estimated income of \$4,000. All members were encouraged to continue to pursue sponsorships.
- c. Currently committed sponsors are Willsey Agency, Inc., J. L. Johnson Jewelers, Legan Mechanical, Best Cabinets, and Arni's Restaurants. Coach Hoover stated that Derrick Thomas has connections with Papa John's and Little Caesars and is working on sponsorships from them.
- d. Restaurant night at Applebee's appeared successful. Flyers were sent in e-blasts and handed out to restaurant patrons while dining. The next Applebee's night is on November 4. Coach Hoover will copy fliers and have them available for pick up at camp. We will have Texas Roadhouse nights, but no dates have been set at this time.

2. Elementary Duals

- a. Jay Yates and Neil Segó will be coaching. Neil Segó will work on getting additional coaches.
- b. Singlets for the elementary team are \$55 each and Coach Hoover will order 22 for the elementary team (which provides four extra singlets). The minimum order is six if we need to order additional singlets. Club singlets are available for purchase by other elementary wrestlers interested in participating in competitions.
- c. Elementary dual tournament dates have been set. Greenwood will be having two tournaments and Coach Hoover proposed attending both of them on November 22 and December 20. Other tournaments to consider are Franklin on 12/6, Perry on 12/13, Columbus East on 01/10. The team will attend 3 to 4 tournaments. Neil will work on setting up friendship meets for all elementary wrestlers to participate.

3. Club Camp

- a. **Promotions:** Flyers were copied and given out for delivery to all Center Grove elementary and middle schools. Jeff Johnson has the yard signs and has been given permission to place them at the schools and will put one at his place of business. Neil Segó will send out e-blasts to all previous club participants. Schools have been notified to plug in a statement about

wrestling club/camp. Jeff Johnson will talk to his Journal representative about getting a free add in the paper.

- b. **Sponsorships:** All potential sponsors that have been contacted need to get Logos in as soon as possible in order to get the Logos on the t-shirts. Latest possible turn in date is the first day of camp, October 26. We will also have a sponsorship table set up during camp registration.
- c. **T-Shirts and Medals:** The design for the t-shirt has been delivered. Deadline for sponsor logos on back of t-shirts, as stated earlier, is set at October 26 at the very latest. Jeff Johnson has counted all medals from previous years and we do not have enough of one kind to give out at tournaments. He will order new medals for the camp and tournaments. Those that we already have can be given out to children for various reasons, like "Wrestler of the Week", etc. Jeff Johnson will pursue the least expensive avenue for purchasing medals. If the medals are ordered on Tuesday, October 27, they will be available in time for the camp tournament on November 5. It will be easier to determine the number of medals needed once registrations are in on October 26.
- d. **Camp Registration:** Monday, October 26 beginning at 5 PM – all board members are asked to be available for registration. Coach Hoover will be requesting 15 tables and 20-30 chairs to set up in the lobby area to the west gym for registration. Neil will have extra registration forms available for registration and cash for change. Scales will be available; they are being calibrated October 14. USAW cards and forms need to be available. Renee needs to turn in our charter money and then she will pick up 150 USAW cards. Coaches need to get their USAW cards before camp. Coach Hoover has pens and can put up the banner. Keith will bring his printer for ease of copying during registration. Tables will also be set up to sell club merchandise. Coach Hoover will ask Jim's wrestling supply if they can be available that night. Neil will make the club practice schedule to hand out at registration.
- e. **Tournament:** The facilities have been requested and we are cleared to use them. It was discussed and decided that the band and not CGWC handle concessions during the tournament.

4. **Friendship Meets**

Neil Segó will contact other schools to organize friendship meets for the elementary students. He will contact local schools only and the meets will be informal.

5. **Website**

- a. Neil Segó has made additions to the website and continues to work on the new site. He asked that if any person has pictures to be included on the site please submit them. If there are any updates for the website, please get them to Neil quickly so that he can post them.
- b. It was discussed that we need the middle schools to submit their schedules and rosters as well as dual meet results so that they can be posted. A parent on each of the teams would be very helpful and prospects were mentioned.

6. **Other / Coach Hoover Discussion Items**

- a. CGWC will host a freestyle tournament on Saturday, April 17, 2010. The gym requests have been made. We will need to find a freestyle head official and other officials for the event.
- b. We now have several wrestlers who have achieved all-American finishes at national events and Coach Hoover would like a board to display the names of those wrestlers. He would also like a board that lists state champions.
- c. November 18, 2009 is the high school red/white dual at 6:30 PM. This will be run like an official high school dual complete with weigh-ins and an IHSAA official. There will be no admission fee for the event and all elementary wrestlers will be invited. This will also be the wrestle-off finals for the high school varsity spots.
- d. The next meeting has been set for Tuesday, November 10, at 6:30 PM.
